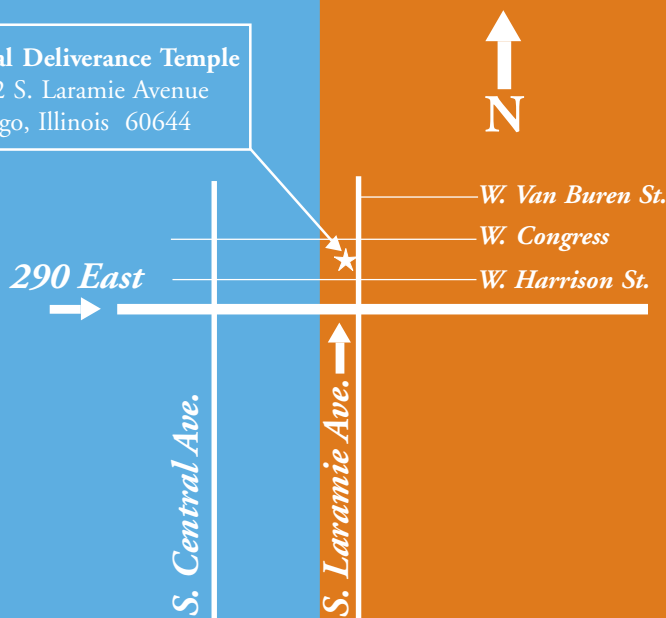

The Chicago Bible Institute is a non-denominational Christian School of Ministry. We offer certificates for each

course completed and diplomas for the completion of fifteen credits. We do not, however, offer college credit nor do we award academic degrees.

Our Purpose Statement

We exist to equip laypeople and church leaders in the inner-city to do the work of the ministry to build up the body of Christ to the glory of God.

Our Doctrinal Statement

- ▶ We believe the Bible to be the inspired Word of God, inerrant in the original writings, and the supreme authority in matters of faith and practice.
- ▶ We believe in one God who exists in the triune persons of Father, Son (Jesus Christ), and Holy Spirit.
- ▶ We believe that the human race was created innocent and pure but fell from this condition through the disobedience of Adam, the first man. We believe therefore, that all people because they are descendants of Adam are by nature spiritually dead and in need of redemption.
- ▶ We believe that through the death of Jesus Christ on the cross, God provides salvation for all who repent of their sins and turn to Him through faith in Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord.

- ▶ We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells all who profess saving faith in Jesus Christ, and that He enables them to follow God's commands and live a life of purity and love.
- ▶ We believe in the personal, physical return of Jesus Christ, the bodily resurrection of Christians to eternal life in God's presence, and in the bodily resurrection of non-Christians to judgment and eternal death in the Lake of Fire.
- ▶ We believe that water baptism and the Lord's supper are to be observed by all Christians during the present age. They are not, however, the means of salvation.

WHAT ARE OUR COURSE AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS?

Course Requirements

- ▶ Students are to complete reading and project assignments.
- ▶ Students are expected to be on time (our courses begin at 7:00pm and end at 9:00pm) and they cannot be more than thirty minutes late.
- ▶ Students must stay for at least one hour and a half in order to receive credit for attendance at any given class.
- ▶ Students must attend at least eleven out of thirteen sessions to receive credit for the course.
- ▶ Students must attend all workshops to receive credit (5 weeks).
- ▶ Students are expected to bring a Bible, notebook and writing materials to class.



Graduation Requirements

- ▶ To receive a diploma, a student must complete fifteen credits.
- ▶ Each course during the Fall & Winter Semester is one credit.
- ▶ All of our workshops are 1/2 credit.
- ▶ All graduation fees must be paid.
